FR DAVID WRITES:

This week we have celebrated the Octave of Easter – a whole week when we celebrate each day as another Easter Day. Today, the Second Sunday of Easter, is the Octave Day of Easter – the eighth day of Easter joy when we celebrate once again that Jesus Christ is truly risen from the dead. Today is also known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. This feast was instituted by Pope John Paul II whose pontificate was in many ways dedicated to Divine Mercy, and in the end, he went to God on the eve of the feast of Divine Mercy in 2005. Pope Francis has announced that, later this year, he will invoke a special Jubilee Year dedicated to mercy.

On Thursday 7 May 7.30pm we will welcome Bishop Nicholas Hudson, our new auxiliary bishop of Westminster, to our parish in his first official visit here. This will be a special Mass to mark my induction but, in reality, I hope it will be a significant celebration for the *entire parish*. Perhaps the last six months have not been the easiest and, after a time of uncertainty and waiting, I hope this event will mark an important moment as we set out together in faith. We will welcome guests and enjoy a celebration afterwards. This is also a good opportunity for me to thank Monsignor Vladimir Felzmann for his work since Fr William left. We are all very grateful to him for his stewardship and wish him well. May 7 is also the day of the General Election but the Bishop does not anticipate that this should be a problem and I'm sure we can all make sure we've voted either before or after Mass. More details to follow on this event in due course but please make a note of the date.

I wish you all every renewed Easter blessing, and I hope you have a good week – especially if you're returning to school or work. Fr David
