Safeguarding - This weekend we will hear Arianna Sommariva introduce herself at the end of all Masses. Arianna is a parishioner whom many of you know already. She has kindly agreed to be our Safeguarding Representative for the parish. I am very grateful that she has generously taken on this important role and the training which goes with it. Arianna's work will involve liaising with the parish, the diocese and myself, in creating a positive culture where safeguarding for all is a key priority in everything we do and undertake.

Harvest Fast Day – I hope that many of you were able to participate in the CAFOD Harvest Day. Please leave your envelopes in the baskets at the end of Mass. This will take the form of a retiring collection. If you have not brought an envelope back this weekend, or would like to make a donation anyway, extra envelopes are available at the back of church which will enable Gift Aid to be claimed on the donation. Failing all else, please leave your cash in the basket on the way out. I do thank you for your generosity to this very important work. As CAFOD wrote to us last week: *“Your support and donations to CAFOD this Harvest Fast Day will enable our partners to work with people across the world to have access to tools and training, and empower them to become self-sufficient despite living in the most difficult of conditions. Additionally, your donations this Fast Day will be used to fund our partners work in Europe and the Middle East to support those affected by the refugee crisis.”*
