- **'Proclaim Westminster'** Yesterday I took part in the Proclaim Westminster conference, wearing my Diocesan 'hat'. I am grateful to Harry Wallis who participated on behalf of St Patrick's. We will hear more concerning the fruits of this meeting in due course.
- **Mass for the Deceased Priests** of our diocese will take place at Westminster Cathedral on Tuesday 24 November, 5.30pm, led by the Cardinal and auxiliary bishops. All are welcome.
- **Jubilee of Mercy** The forthcoming Holy Year begins on Tuesday 8 December, the Immaculate Conception. There will be a special Mass at Westminster Cathedral that day, at 5.30pm.
- **Jubilee of Mercy for Young People** The diocese will hold a special Mass on Friday 11 December, at the Centre for Youth Ministry, St Aloysius Church, Euston. This Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Nicholas to mark the start of the Holy Year for young people in our diocese. There will be music from the renowned composer Edwin Fawcett and his young musical scholars. I would like to invite secondary school students and sixth formers from our parish to join me.
