FR DAVID WRITES - This will be the last newsletter before the summer. The newsletter will resume in the new school term. After this week, please consult the notice on the church door for Mass times and intentions. The weekend Masses (Saturday evening, Sunday morning, and Sunday evening) are all as normal. There will be a weekday Mass each Wednesday morning at 9.00am (apart from 20 July when we have a Funeral for Maureen Sullivan at 11.00am).

On Monday 18 July I will leave for World Youth Day in Poland. This is a slight misnomer as it is not 'one day' but two weeks! We will take 220 young people from the diocese including one person from our parish. We begin in the city of Lodz where we will join the Chemin-Neuf movement for 'Paradise in the City' – a week-long event organised by the local diocese. After this, we will visit the Shrine of the Black Madonna at Jasna Gora and then head to Krakow for the World Youth Day festival itself. We will welcome Pope Francis and participate in the jubilee for young people which is the pulsing heart of the Holy Year of Mercy. Our pilgrimage will be led by Cardinal Nichols and Bishop Nicholas. I will pray for you all, invoking especially the prayers of St John Paul II (who was bishop of Krakow before his election as pope) and St Faustina, apostle of Divine Mercy. Please pray for us, and for a safe and blessed journey.

After World Youth Day, I will take my annual vacation. Please contact Lucy or Arnold in the presbytery for anything urgent. Otherwise, please leave other matters for the resumption of normal service at the end of the summer. I would like to thank Fr Damian, Fr John and Fr Alan for their generous support and supply over the summer – I am sure we are all most grateful.

I wish you all every blessing for the summer and your own vacations. Please remember, wherever you may be, there are no holidays from church or going to Mass! God bless you all.
